Information on data processing pursuant to Article 13 of the General Data Protection Regulation

The image, video and sound recordings will be processed in accordance with Article 6(1)(a) of the Data Protection Regulation on the basis of your consent and published in accordance with § 22 KunstUrhG (German Art Copyright Act).

The recordings will be stored permanently.

You are entitled to the following rights if the legal requirements are met:

- The right to information about personal data concerning you (Article 15 Data Protection Regulation)
- The right to have inaccurate personal data relating to you corrected (Article 16 of the data protection regulation)
- The right to erasure of personal data (Article 17 of the Data Protection basic regulation)
- The right to restriction of the processing of personal data (Article 18 of the Data Protection Regulation)
- The right to object to the processing of personal data (Article 21 General Data Protection Regulation)

Requests to this effect should be addressed to the data controllers.

You also have the right under Article 77 of the General Data Protection Regulation to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority if you consider that the processing of personal data concerning you is not carried out lawfully.
